Feedback from number of people has shown us that there is a lot of value in these meetings and will continue to regularly schedule them.

There will be several opportunities for your Association to join in the conversation - starting with this communication. We would love to hear about any section of Hockey NSW's Constitution your Association feels could benefit from review, and what you would like to see added or altered.
