

Officiating Update – Tamika White

- When a game is deferred, the two teams that are playing are meant to organise Umpires and Tech Bench with the originally allocated teams. Do the clubs agree to this?
 - What are the implications of the deferred game teams umpiring and tech benching their own games?
 - o **Outcome:** Each team has to organise their own umpire and tech bench, regardless of which club they derive from.
- **Suggestion:** When planning the competition for next Winter season, add in a middle and end weekends to fill for deferrals.
- Reminder to clubs that they need to let Tamika know who your umpire is by Wednesday nights.
 - O Clubs are still responsible for finding their own umpires and will lose points if they do not do so. This is part of the playing rules.
- Behaviour reminder:
 - o Umpires being harassed
 - o Umpires making poor remarks towards the players as well
 - o Tech bench needs to not make inflammatory comments as well
 - o Non-officials not allowed in the tech bench
