

2022 Fees – Amy Smart

- Playing Fees Version 2
- Discussion around changing the playing fees, to be in line with Hockey NSW and Hockey Australia (the same fee regardless of Seniors or Juniors participation).
- Agreement to leave the playing fees as is, and clubs will ensure their players are registered through their portal if they are a junior player (16 and under).
- Agreement to allow Juniors playing into Seniors for free for their first year to encourage their participation
- Amy to update the playing fees.

FIH Hockey Playing Rules Update

- Rules of Hockey | FIH
- Implementation and Authority

The Rules of Hockey apply to all hockey players and officials. National Associations have discretion to decide the date of implementation at national level. The date of implementation for international competition is 1 January 2022.

The Rules are issued by the FIH Rules Committee under the authority of the International Hockey Federation. Copyright is held by the International Hockey Federation.

Rule Changes

- Rule 4.2 was changed to allow for defending players using Penalty Corner protective equipment to continue to play the ball outside the circle after intercepting during the taking of a penalty corner. Players can now continue to run with the ball while keeping their protective equipment on but they must remove that same equipment immediately after the first opportunity to do so and always inside the 23 m area. No player using PC protective equipment can play the ball outside the 23 m area at any time.
- Rule 9.10 was changed to allow for the playing of what is commonly designated as Aerial Balls. The previous text did cover for the possibility for players to safely intercept a falling ball, which is now seen as both legitimate and positive to the development of the game. Aerial Balls will continue to be closely monitored by all stakeholders so that player safety can be maintained.
 - Charmain has videos that demonstrate this change.
- The mandatory experiment Rule 2.2, allowing teams to play with a Field Player with Goalkeeping Privileges has been incorporated in the rules. There are now two options: to play with a Goalkeeper who wears protective equipment comprising at least headgear, leg guards and kickers and who is also permitted to wear goalkeeping hand protectors and other protective equipment or play with Field Players only. Any player changes other than these should be treated as a substitution.
- o In the last Rules of Hockey update in January 2021, Rule 13.5g had been removed. It stated that the awarding of a bully would be one of the conditions that would determine the completion of a PC. This is no longer possible, as now any stoppage of play for injury or other reasons during the taking of a penalty corner is a retake of the penalty corner per Rule 6.5d.
- Other changes were merely clarifications, such as the rewording of rule in 6.5d to make the intention of the rule clear. The word "NOT" was removed (as in the previous text this led to an opposite interpretation of the rule).

Competition Discussion – Mel Chyb

 - These will be held as Come and Try Days. Players will need to register to an event in Revolutionise to cover themselves for any injuries that may occur.
- Discussion around holding 'friendlys' with other associations
 - o Men going to Albury in the next few weeks for a competition
 - Ken to follow up with Albury Wodonga regarding the Hockey ACT affiliation registration fees
- Competition structure
 - Looking at Options to regards to feedback that we normally receive, for example:
 - Keep Men Div 3 → Div 1, reverse Women Div 1 → Div 3
 - Survey Monkey to all players to assist with understanding the time slots
 - Mel to put together the questions and send to Amy
 - Clubs to promote this to their members
