7.1 – President Report

President Report Committee Meeting: 25 March 2019

I would like to thank all clubs for their support around the restructure of the Snr competition, and this will now give all clubs the opportunity to focus on the development opportunities for your club without the added burden of trying to fill every grade over every weekend.

Last weekend I attended the annual Hockey NSW President Forum and AGM. This was attended by moist associations across NSW. A presentation pack will be provided cockering all of the guest speakers, and once I receive this I will brief all

clubs.

One thing i did glean from the forum is that we are on track with our future strategies, and I was pleased by the No of associations that wanted to know about the good things we are doing in Wagga.

From a board perspective we are still have vacancies and still require an Events and Facilities Manager. The Facilities Manager is a critical on as the role also incorporates the canteen supervision.

At this stage unless something changes we will have no canteen in 2019.

From a facilities perspective:

. Both turfs have now had their annual clean and maintenance

. Repairs to Noonan turf have been completed. We will need to ensure that annual maintenance on Noonan is completed to ensure the longevity of the field.

. The new storage works construction should commence within the next 2 weeks. Just finalising Council requirements.

. The new goals and Nets for Noonon field will be delivered before the commencement of competition.

. We are also seeking quotes to repair the nets where the practise circles are on Paul field.

Looking forward to a great start to the 2019 Winter Season.
