### WWCHA- Presidents Report-23 January 2017

Firstly thank you for the opportunity to be your President for the 2017 season. I very much enjoyed last and have learnt a lot about what a great association we have and the potential we have to be the leading regional association in NSW.

Having our AGM last year, has allowed the new Board plenty of time to plan and assess what is required for us to conduct a successful 2017 season.

This year is an exciting year for us with a number of key events being hosted by WWCHA. These include:

- . NSW Girls Under 15 Championships
- 5 year strategy planning session hosted by Hockey NSW
- . Steakhouse Cup
- . Pakham Cup
- . Wagga Masters Games.

Along with our annual presentation night and grand final day I cant wait for the season to start.

One of our most important events is our Strategy Planning session to be held on Saturday 18 February 2017.

This session to be hosted by Hockey NSW will allow us to focus on developing our future strategy to grow and develop the game of hockey across the Riverina. We will also be covering training on the new Revolutionise platform.

It is expected that all current club presidents and secretaries will attend along with any hockey community member who would like to contribute and share their ideas.

Final details of the day will be advised in due course.

On a facilities front you will see that the installation of our safety nets has commenced and will finalise in the next couple of days. Other planned facility enhancements are:

- Finalisation of the repairs to the grandstands. We have secured a grant of \$5K from the NSW Community Partnerships to assist with this completion.
- . Repaint of the dugouts, grandstands and container

- Installation of shoe cleaners for both fields
- . Purchase of blower to assist with the weekly cleaning of the fields.
- Assessing the potential to purchase a new PA system as well new WWCHA tear drop flags to be used as promotion at events in Wagga and at State Championships.
- . Annual maintenance of the 2 turfs, which is critical in extending the timeframe for replacement.
- . Further discussion with WWCC re the new user agreement for Jubilee Park.

We will also be launching the new representative uniform. Karen will talk more about this exciting change.

On a coaching and development note, we will be meeting with the CEO of the Southern Sports Academy (early February) to discuss the potential to have Hockey placed back in their programs. We will be joined by Richard Willis (Athlete Acceleration Program Manager, Hockey NSW), to assist in the discussions.

Finally and most importantly we still have 2 vacancies on the board. These are Events and Facilities.

These are 2 very important roles, given the number of events we have this year as well as the number of changes to our facilities.

Please have a think about filling these roles or looking within your club for someone who would love the opportunity to contribute to Wagga Hockey at the association level.
