

2022 COVID-19 Policy – Match Rules

COVID Rule Protocols:

Matches may be impacted by players who have tested Positive to COVID-19, and will be managed as follows:

- Divisions where there is a team(s) to fill from:
 - 1-4 players out expected to fill from division below
 - 5 or more can be rescheduled
- Divisions where there is **not** a team to fill from: No limit to players
- A team can reschedule a game once per Winter season due to COVID

Updates to COVID settings

Household and close contacts

Household and close contacts do not need to self-isolate if you do not have any symptoms, but must follow <u>NSW Health household and close contact guidelines</u> for 7 days from the last time someone in your household tested positive to COVID-19, or as otherwise directed by NSW Health if you are a close contact.

There are no changes to the advice for people who test positive to COVID-19. You must self-isolate for 7 days from the date of your positive test and follow the <u>testing positive to COVID-19 and managing COVID-19</u> <u>safely at home</u> advice.
